

Employee Welfare

In the interest of Health and Safety and Employee welfare all staff must ensure cleanliness whilst working with Lead and other hazardous materials.

Employees should;

- Use disposable clothing, provided by Humphrey and Stretton.
- Use gloves, provided by Humphrey and Stretton.
- Wash hands before and after use of the hazardous materials, making sure soap pumps are wiped down after use.
- Ensure you **DO NOT** touch eyes, mouth and skin until the correct cleaning procedure has been carried out on the individual. **This is including having an itch** as this could pose the individual in Medical Danger by exposing and making skin contact with Hazardous materials.

If any staff member feels they have been in skin contact with Lead and other Hazardous Materials they should thoroughly wash the affected area and seek on-site First Aid assistance where the appropriate care will be given.

ONLY USE ELECTRIC HAND DRYER OR HAND TOWELS TO AVOID CONTAMINATION.

For wipes for after use cleaning ask your Factory Managers.
